What are the benefits of choosing a 'pre-need' site?

Purchasing a memorial in advance ensures your wishes are

carried out and a site of your choice is selected. This takes the task of selecting a memorial site away from the family at an extremely emotional time and secures the cost of the site at today's prices. A burial licence is for 50 years.

What are my payment options?

You can pay in full at the time of the appointment or a 30 day account can be issued.

Alternatively a 6 month lay-by can be arranged. We accept cash, cheque, money order, EFTPOS, Visa card and MasterCard.

Does the purchase of the pre-need site include the interment fees?

No, you are purchasing the pre-need site only. There is an additional cost for interment.

When does the 50 years start from – the day we order the site or from the day it is paid?

The tenure of 50 years starts from the date the site is ordered.

What happens if I don't use the site for many years?

Burial licences can be extended after 5 years up to a maximum of 50 years from today's date. Please note - this is not compulsory. Anyone can top up the licence to a grave after 5 years has expired on the licence. Otherwise, the licence can be extended from the date the 50 years expires.

How many licence holders can there be per burial site?

There can be up to two (2) licence holders. Please advise the consultant at your appointment if you wish to have this option.

Does the Cemetery provide and maintain lawn in the beam section?

The licence fee for plots in the standard beam section does not include planting grass on graves or the watering of established grass. Lawn 1, 2, 3, Derrick Gardens and Lutheran Lawn are the only burial sections irrigated at Centennial Park.

Burial Options

2011 / 2012

Centennial Park Cemetery accommodates all forms of burial such as lawn and vault burials and includes general and specific religious sections such as Bahá'í, Catholic, Druses, Jewish, Lutheran, Muslim and Orthodox.

Burial licences are issued for 50 years. At any time during this period, the licence may be renewed up to a maximum of 50 years from the date of expiry. In most areas it is possible to have three interments.

Licence for a burial plot

A licence for a burial plot may be purchased in advance of actual use. This is known as 'pre-need' and a surcharge is charged on a licence fee when a family selects the site.

In most areas of the beam section it is possible for a grave to hold up to three burials and unlimited cremated remains.

The erection of a monument or additional inscription to the existing monument is subject to approval by Centennial Park. Monumental work must be conducted by an authorised person and is subject to a permit fee.

If a companion site is ordered through the funeral director within five (5) working days of a burial, a surcharge will not apply. When a licence is already held, an interment/opening fee is applicable. A minimum of 10 years must be current on the licence prior to a burial.
